## **DRIVER LEARNER'S PERMIT LICENSE - Applicant must provide:**

- 1. DE-964 Certificate for Learner Permit License {green half sheet from the driving school- shows 6 hours Laws & Signs completed and passed both Laws & Signs Exam}
- 2. Application for Learner's License and \$16 License Fee {cash, check, credit cards or money order}
- 3. VOE {Verification of School Enrollment} Obtain this from the school's Registrar's office.
- 4. Original Birth Certificate (no copies) or a Valid US Passport
- 5. Social Security Card signed
- 6. Proof of Residency Parents Two forms of residency proof:
  - a. current utility bill showing BOTH\* (unless divorced\*) parent names and address AND
  - b. One bank, mortgage or insurance statement showing <u>BOTH</u>\* parent names and address
